

Bios Urn

Your Bios Urn is made up of two sections, the top capsule which holds the growth medium for your seedling and the base (or urn) which holds your pet's ashes.

We recommend choosing a seedling from your local garden centre to ensure the plant is suited to your soil conditions.

Directions

Lawnswood has already placed your pet's ashes into the base of your Bios Urn.

Keeping both sections together, remove the tear-away paper on the top capsule and empty the growth medium from the bag into this capsule, along with some soil from your garden.

Loosen the roots of your selected seedling and plant your seedling into the growth medium. Empty any remaining soil from the seedling pot into the growth medium.

Bury your Bios Urn deep enough so that the top of the urn is 3-5cm below ground level.

Your plant is now ready to water and take care of.

Frequently Asked Questions

How long will it take for my Bios Urn to biodegrade?

Depending on the level of moisture in your soil, your Bios Urn should biodegrade within 6 to 10 weeks.

How long can my Bios Urn sit on the shelf before it biodegrades?

Your Bios Urn should not biodegrade if it is stored in a dry place and not exposed to moisture.

Can I put my Bios Urn into a pot?

Yes, as long as the pot size is suitable for your Bios Urn and the seedling you have chosen.

Why should I buy a seedling over a seed?

Seedlings tend to be easier and faster to grow and are usually hardened to the local climate. Choosing a seedling may also help with the grieving process.
